cylinder		from κυλίω (kulíō) I roll or wallow (intransitive)
Flute		From Latin flātus (“blowing”)
Stick		
Branch		Late Latin branca (“footprint”, later also “paw, claw”)
Stem		from Proto-Indo-European *steh₂- (“to stand, stay”).
Stalk		Ancient Greek στέλος (stélos, “beam”),
Pedicle		From Latin pediculus (“little foot”), diminutive of pēs.
Peduncle		From Late Latin pedunculus, from pedis, genitive of pēs (“foot”).
cane		Ancient Greek κάνα (kána, “reed”),
